Recipe of the Month

Sweet Corn Bruschetta

- · 4 ears sweet corn, husks removed
- 3 tablespoons balsamic vinegar
- 1 tablespoon honey
- 1 tablespoon granulated sugar
- ¼ cup basil leaves, cut into wide strips
- Salt and ground black pepper
- 18 ounce baguette-style french bread
- ¼ cup olive oil (scant cup)
- 4 ounces goat cheese (chevre)

Preheat broiler. Using a sharp knife, cut kernels off the ears of corn. Combine kernels, honey, sugar, and vinegar, toss to coat. Stir in basil, season with salt and pepper to taste. Brush both sides of each bread slice with olive oil, and arrange on a broiler pan.

Broil bread slices 4- to 5-inches from the heat for 1 to 3 minutes, flip them over, and broil for another 1 to 2 minutes or until golden. Remove from oven, spread each slice with goat cheese. With slotted spoon, top each bruschetta with corn mixture. Serve immediately.
