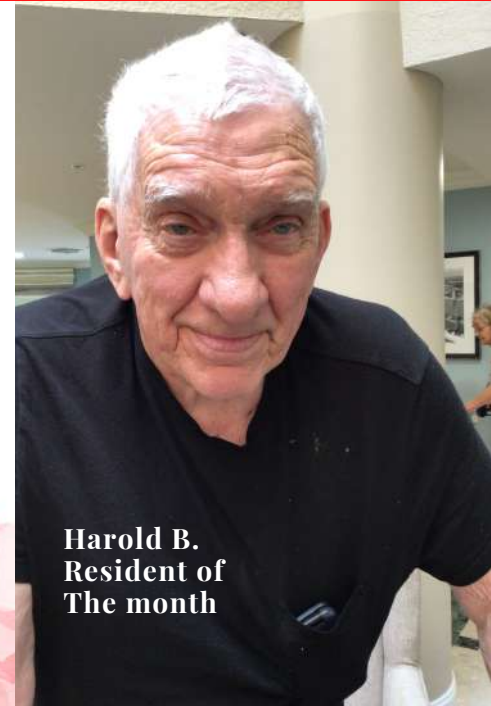

Donations & Requests

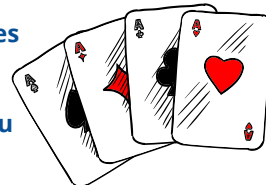
I would like to thank everyone that has donated to our Kindness Matters Volunteer program to feed the homeless.
